The description must be sent in the **text section** of your email message (attachments are often screened out by many institutional servers). The position will be posted on ELAM's private listserv where it will be available to current and former ELAM fellows. The listserv posting will give approximately 400 academic medicine women leaders an opportunity to self-select for the position or to forward it to another colleague.
